Everyone within our sport plays a role in safeguarding Children and Young People. In the event of an incident, disclosure, complaint, allegation or suspicion of Prohibited Conduct, follow these important steps – further information can be found in Australian Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children and Young People.

### STEP 1

**CHILD REPORTS, YOU OBSERVE, SUSPECT OR ARE INFORMED OF AN INCIDENT OF PROHIBITED CONDUCT**

### STEP 2

**IF A CHILD IS IN  
IMMEDIATE DANGER,  
RISK OF HARM OR  
FOR EMERGENCIES  
CONTACT POLICE  
AND AMBULANCE  
ON TRIPLE-0**

**REPORT TO THE

THE POLICE  
(DETAILS BELOW)  
AS SOON AS  
POSSIBLE**

**REPORT TO THE NOMINATED  
CHILD SAFETY OFFICER  
OR MEMBER PROTECTION  
INFORMATION OFFICER WITHIN  
YOUR ASSOCIATION OR CLUB AND  
ENSURE YOUR STATE/TERRITORY  
ASSOCIATION IS ADVISED**
